No Kid Hungry's Impact in Oklahoma

Six year-old Crystal's parents aren't always able to provide enough for her to eat at home. This is especially true in the summer, when school meals aren't available and Crystal's family struggles to stretch their food budget. No Kid Hungry and our partners, like the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma in Oklahoma City, are ending childhood hunger in Oklahoma.



With help from No Kid Hungry, the Regional Food Bank was able to run 93 summer meals sites, a new record for the organization. The Regional Food Bank was able to add 20 new sites through local partnerships with summer programs such as the YMCA, local schools and parks and recreation centers. Summer was once a season of hunger for many kids in Oklahoma, but we're changing that. By investing in practical solutions that connect children to food, like marketing campaigns in low-income communities, we ensure the summer months are no longer a time of uncertainty for kids like Crystal.
