No Kid Hungry's Impact in Arkansas

Six year-old Ida's parents aren't always able to provide enough for her to eat at home. No Kid Hungry and our partners are expanding school breakfast to reach kids in need like Ida. We're working with schools to build breakfast programs that work for their students – like the 'Bus Line Breakfast Program' at Pottsville Middle Grade School in Arkansas. With funding from No



Kid Hungry, the school was able to purchase the equipment they needed to create this Grab & Go style breakfast program. Students step off the bus and are able to grab breakfast from a nearby kiosk, eating with friends or heading to the classroom before the first bell rings.

"When we first started," shared school staff, "we had a lot of kids thanking us for breakfast. I think they could tell that we care about their health and well-being by providing an easier way for them to eat in the morning". By investing in practical solutions that feed kids like Ida and her classmates at Pottsville, No Kid Hungry is making sure that every child is cared for and that no child goes hungry.
