## No Kid Hungry's Impact in Wyoming

Ten year-old Dylan's parents aren't always able to provide enough for him to eat at home. This is especially true in the summer, when school meals aren't available and Dylan's family struggles to stretch their food budget. No Kid Hungry and our partners, like the Wyoming Department of Education, are ending childhood hunger in Wyoming by working with



community programs across the state to offer free summer meals to children in need. With funding from No Kid Hungry, nine community groups were able to create new signage and displays to ensure that kids and their families knew where they could go to get free meals. The signage is critical to ensure that each site offers a welcoming and safe environment to families who may be uncomfortable or confused when visiting a program for the first time.

Summer is a season of hunger for many kids, but we're changing that. By investing in practical solutions that feed kids, we ensure the summer months are no longer a time of uncertainty for kids like Dylan and their families.
